## KCS Bible Bowl Competition



West End hosted the Knoxville Area Kids 4 Christ Bible Bowl March 30 at Knoxville Christian School. The goal is to encourage young people K-12<sup>th</sup> grade to read and study their Bible. This year we studied the book of Exodus. A total of 69 students participated on 18 teams from 6 congregations and schools representing Eastside, Jefferson City, KCS, Hardin Valley, Karns, and West End in elementary and middle/high school divisions. Our participants from West End were Robert Moore Davis, Reese Sherwood, Owen Sherwood, Klinsman Vindel, Kennedy Lynch, Annalee Davis, Carisma Carpenter, Sydney Chan, Tyler Chan, Colby Johnson, Addelyn Johnson, Baylor Houston, Madeline Miller, Callen Johnson, Lochlyn Rankin, Daycey Sherwood, Jayden Childress, Jaycob Childress, Cintia Hernandez, Collin Kiles and Katherine Guzman. The team of Owen Sherwood, Carisma Carpenter, Annalee Davis and Madeline Miller got the first place team award in the elementary division. In the middle/high school division the team of Reese Sherwood, Robert Moore Davis, Tyler Chan and Sydney Chan tied for the first place team award. The following students received individual awards in the elementary division out of 60 questions. Madeline Miller and Owen Sherwood tied for third place with 50 correct answers and Carisma Carpenter and Annalee Davis tied for first place with 56 correct answers. Reese Sherwood received an individual award in the middle/high school division, he answered 58 questions correctly. Owen Sherwood was recognized as the Outstanding Student in the elementary division for having the highest cumulative score for all 4 years of participation from the second through the fifth grade receiving 965 points over 4 years out of 1200.
