
Boys 2 Men | **Various Teachers** | Lighthouse | HS & MS Girls

ADULT SUNDAY MORNING

The Pentateuch | Hector Cortez | Room 217

How do you see the Old Testament Scriptures? How do you especially see the Scripture of Moses? Jesus said: For if you believed Moses, you would believe me; for he wrote of me. ⁴⁷ But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe my words?"

The writings of Moses are precious to Christians because they deal with God's work with Israel, in preparation for the Messiah that would come, not only to save Israel, but to save the world from the power and punishment of sin.

The Parables of Jesus | Geoff Johnson | Room 221

The parables Jesus taught present clear stories from everyday events that many in the crowd would recognize. Jesus did not code His teaching to prevent some people from understanding, since all equally would understand the imagery. All those gathered could comprehend the aspects of the stories related to their everyday lives. We today can learn from these same teachings. How do these parables fit into our everyday lives?

1 Corinthians | Mark Newby & Will Cleveland | Auditorium

First Corinthians contains a frank discussion of the church and the issues that impacted real people in the first century. The Corinthian church was deep in sin on a variety of fronts, so Paul provided an important model for how the church should handle the problem of sin in its midst. How do we, both individually and collectively, fit into this model.

New Christian Class | Adam Wilson & Mark Sloan | Room 240 (Hispanic Classroom)

So now that I am a Christian what's next? What do I need to learn to truly become a disciple of Jesus Christ? What do I need to know about the unique nature of the Lord's church? Why do we worship the way we do? These, and other questions, will be examined in this class which is designed for those who have recently been baptized or who have recently placed membership here at West End. The class will cover basics in the Bible that will help the student understand more about the Lord's church and how to live the Christian life.

The Shadow of the Cross | Room 204 (Single Again Ladies)

This is a class for women who are single again through divorce or death. Walk with the Savior from Gethsemane to Golgotha and recognize anew the power that radiates from the shadow of the cross, as you focus on the foundation of our hope as Christians – the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus.

As we navigate through the quarter each teacher will be in charge of teaching on a specific spiritual discipline while also providing some take home material. Man of God | Jeremy Weekley | Room 217 (Men's Class)

In 1 Corinthians 16:13 Paul reminded the men of Corinth to, "Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong." This seems to be a classic depiction of what we would think of when we think of a godly man as a leader: someone strong, spiritually mature, etc., but is this the complete picture? Aren't men human; not superhuman? Do we always have to be strong to lead as we should? Is Satan tricking us into thinking we have to have it all figured out all the time. A quick look at men in the Bible reveals that we don't always get it right. This quarter will study what being a man of God really is and how it should define our lives by examining the good and the bad we find in men in the Bible.

The Book of Jeremiah reflects the ever-worsening situation Jeremiah encountered. Jeremiah had the unenviable tasks of challenging the religious hypocrisy, economic dishonesty and oppressive practices of Judah's leaders and those who followed them. This class will explore the works of Jeremiah and the prophecies he gave to the nation of Israel.
