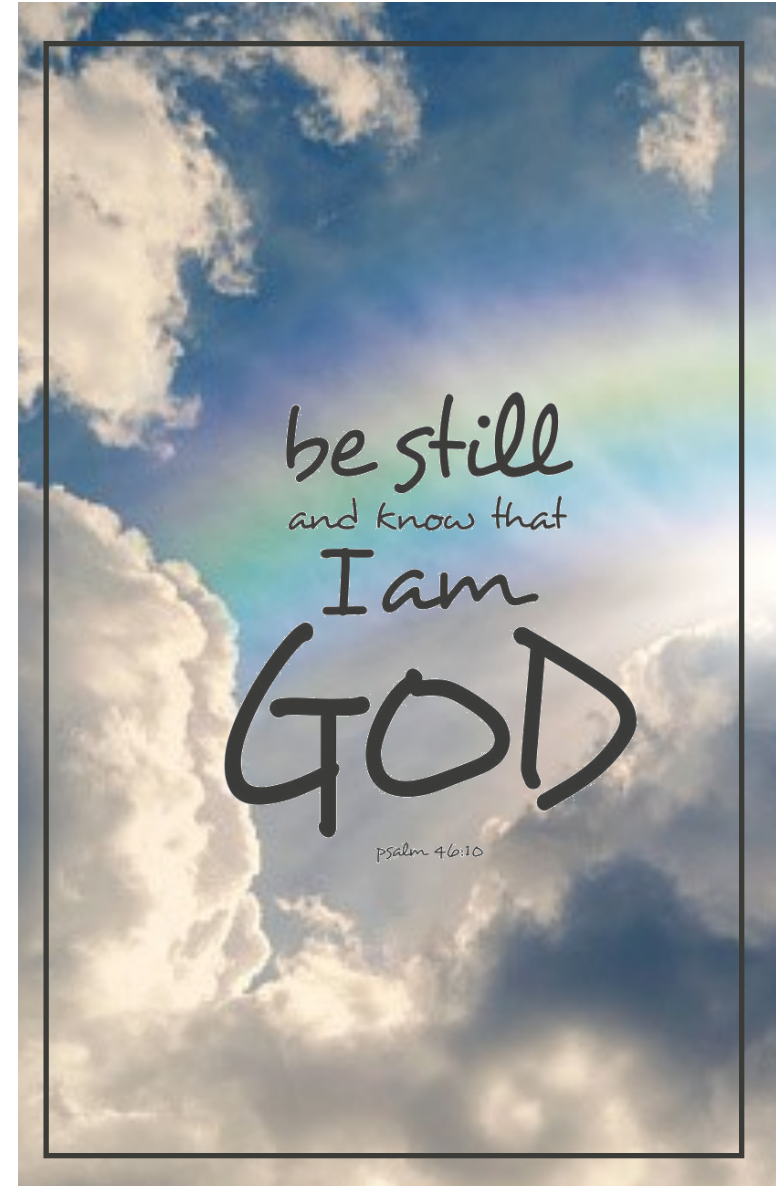

Sharon Markardt's son, Brent Markwardt, is scheduled for surgery Tuesday, March 17, due to a foot infection. He lives in Dallas, TX.

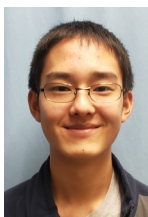

Laiton Pigg responded March 11 requesting prayers of encouragement.

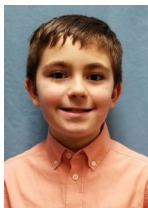
Kristin Howell responded March 15 requesting prayers for herself and fiancé **Matt Ward** as they begin their life together.
