**REASSEMBLY PLAN**

As we approach our time to meet again the elders want to share with everyone the plan for how we will assemble.

- There will be two identical Sunday worship services beginning June 7 at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. The auditorium and foyer will be sanitized between the services.
- The **Connect Groups** have been used to assign those who will attend the 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. service. This helps us to have room to allow distance between members/families. The groups have been assigned on a rotating basis each week in order to allow for diverse fellowship of the church family throughout June. If your name does not appear in a Connect Group please notify the office. The schedule is as follows:

- Designated entry points are the doors entering both sides of the main foyer. The doors will be propped open to enable no-touch entry. Do not enter the building through any other doors.
- Communion will utilize self-contained sealed cups. These will be made available in a safe manner upon arrival.
- Giving will remain available online as well as a central collection box in the foyer.
- There will be no children’s classes, TLC, nursery or playground use when we meet.
- Wearing masks is strongly encouraged. Reusable masks from the Knox County Health Department will be made available for those who may not have one.
- Please practice social distancing inside the building. Six-foot distancing between families or individuals should be observed on the pews, they will be marked to facilitate this.
- Refrain from bathroom use unless absolutely necessary. Use only the facilities near the auditorium.
- Valet service will not be available
- Extended visiting should be done outside the building with careful consideration of others.
- The elders strongly encourage anyone who is in a high-risk category to stay at home for now. *All services will be available online.*
- ***If you are ill or exhibiting any symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc. please stay home to avoid putting others at risk. If a person attending a service tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of attending a service, all people who had been present will need to be notified, a more in-depth cleaning will be necessary and other mitigating measures may be warranted at that time. If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 after attending a service please contact one of the elders or ministers. This will be kept confidential.***

**Sunday and Wednesday classes** will be online across all platforms during June.

**Sunday Bible Class** - 6 p.m. Mark Newby will be teaching 1 Corinthians.

**Wednesday Summer Series** - 7 p.m. taught by various teachers.
