- ◆ Tremont Lodge will be on the right.

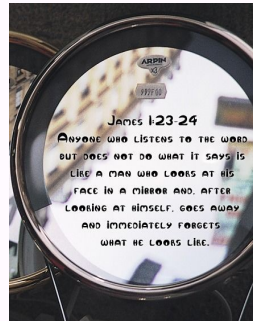
