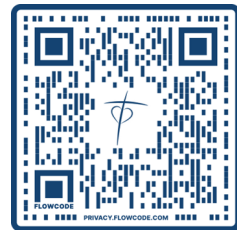

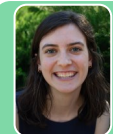

A facilitator will lead an in-depth discussion of our Sunday morning sermon topic. A devotional will follow in the auditorium.

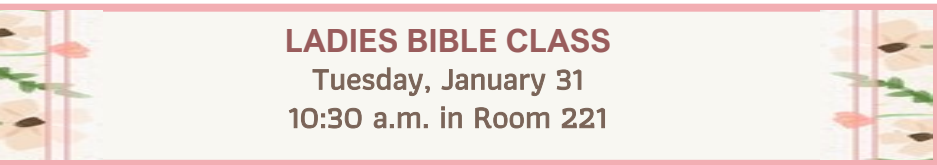
