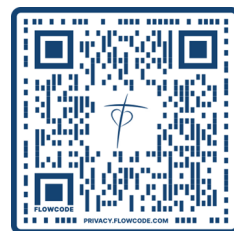

Judi Atwell had a CT scan April 26 and will begin another round of infusions to treat follicular lymphoma primary bone cancer.

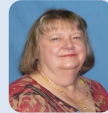
Mark and Lori Burroughs' granddaughter, Cordelia Bouch, is home following hospitalization for pneumonia.

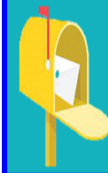

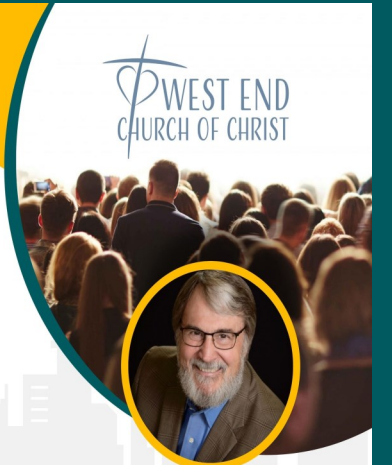
